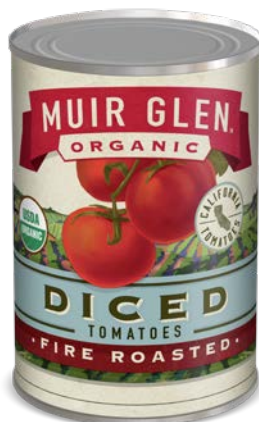
### HOT SAUCE
